DAMAGE ASSESSMENT GUIDELINES



1. General Structural Safety

Check for visible cracks or movement in walls, floors, and ceilings.

- Inspect for sagging roofs, ceilings, or walls.
- Look for foundation erosion or shifting.
- Ensure doors and windows function properly.

Check stairs, railings, and walkways for stability.

2. Electrical & Gas Safety

- Look for exposed or damaged wiring.
- Check if electrical panels, outlets, or appliances were submerged.
- Have gas lines and appliances inspected for leaks.
- Smell for gas if detected, leave immediately and call your provider.

3. Water & Plumbing

- 🗹 Check for pipe leaks or breaks.
- Flush water lines before use to remove contamination.

Ensure toilets, sinks, and drains are functioning properly.

- Test water pressure for irregularities.
- Have well water tested before consumption.

4. Interior Damage

Inspect walls, floors, and ceilings for water stains, bubbling, or warping.

- Check for peeling paint or wallpaper.
- Assess furniture, cabinets, and shelving for water damage.

Remove and dispose of contaminated carpets, rugs, and upholstery.

5. Mould & Mildew

- Inspect damp areas for visible mould growth (walls, ceilings, floors, HVAC systems).
- Use dehumidifiers and fans to dry affected areas.
- Clean and disinfect mould-prone surfaces.

Hire a professional for large-scale mould removal.

6. Business Equipment & Inventory

Inspect machinery and office equipment for water exposure.

- Dry and assess IT equipment (computers, phones, servers) before powering on.
- Check stock and inventory for water or contamination damage.
- Dispose of perishable or contaminated goods.

7. External Property & Landscaping

- Check outdoor structures (signage, fences, sheds) for damage.
- Assess the condition of driveways, parking lots, and walkways.
- Clear debris from drainage systems and stormwater outlets.
- Inspect trees and landscaping for instability or root damage.

8. Documentation & Insurance

- Take photos/videos of all damages before starting repairs.
- Create a list of damaged assets with estimated costs.
- Keep receipts for repairs and replacement purchases.
- Contact your insurance provider for guidance on filing a claim.
