You will be using our MIMS App (Mojay Pots Inventory Management App) to conduct stock counts at Garden Centres and other stockists around NSW. Many products are now barcoded but you will need to be a quick learner to be able to conduct stocktakes efficiently – especially when product are not labelled.

This role will form a key part of the sales chain and you must be able to travel regionally each week (approx. 3 days with vehicle and accommodation provided), with local work in and around Sydney and surrounds for the other 2 days.

Some of your responsibilities as **Sales Support Representative** include:

- Using the Mojay Pots Inventory Management System (MIMS) App on a phone, tablet, or laptop to record stock counts in Garden Centres. A device will be supplied to enable barcode scanning where available.
- Submit completed counts and take photos of displays and any damaged pots to send to the office.
- Working closely with the Senior Sales Representative who analyses stock count data to produce sales orders – phone and email contact with the Senior Sales Representative after completing stock counts for any clarification.
- Provide basic customer support including help with credits and returns such as placing returns on a pallet to be collected by our driver.
- Working to a structured sales calendar and delivery schedule.
